SOUTH PADRE ISLAND BEACH OPEN TO BEACHGOERS

WHAT: South Padre Island city beaches – an approximate 5-mile stretch – are **OPEN** to beachgoers. Weather conditions are currently sunny and breezy with a high of 94 degrees and a low of 81 degrees with a 0 percent chance of precipitation in the forecast.

The South Padre Island CVB welcomes visitors to enjoy the shoreline, beach activities and water attractions. As always, visitors of all ages are encouraged to use general caution for safe play in and out of the water.

WHO: “The City of South Padre Island welcomes visitors and their families to enjoy the widest, cleanest beach in Texas today – and throughout the summer season - as our city beaches are open to beachgoers,” **said South Padre Island CVB Executive Director Keith Arnold.** “Despite the recent news, our beaches are open; however, driving on city beaches is not permitted.”

MORE DETAILS: The entire length of South Padre Island city beaches does not allow driving, regardless of weather conditions. Driving is allowed only on the North Padre Island National Seashore and county beaches.
